John Hammond Boxill is the chief operating officer of New Salem Baptist Church. Prior to his current position, Boxill has a long history of health related positions, including: manager of chapter services for the American Red Cross of Greater Columbus; program manager for community development at the Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Research Institute; and, operations coordinator, director of health promotions and HIV/AIDS coordinator at the ECCO Family Health Center.

Boxill also serves as a board and development committee member of the Metropolitan Residential Services Board, a board member of the Columbus Area Community Mental Health Center, and as a charter member of the National Black Leadership Initiative on Cancer. Additionally, he has volunteered for United Way of Franklin County, the American Heart Association, the American Cancer Society and the Columbus AIDS Task Force.
