Augustus G. Parker III is founder and president of Columbus Women's Care Inc., also serves as the director of Mount Carmel Obstetrical and Gynecology Clinical Services and the house officer director. Additionally, Dr. Parker works in an administrative position with Mount Carmel Health Systems overseeing quality of care related to obstetrics and gynecology issues.

A graduate of the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, Dr. Parker previously worked as chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Grant Medical Center, clinical instructor at The Ohio State University, department chairman at the Ohio State University East and president of the local chapter of the National Medical Association. Additionally, he pioneered several innovative obstetrical surgical techniques and invented medical devices and tools used in practice today. Dr. Parker also engineered the mobile health units currently serving Columbus Public Schools.

Dr. Parker has served numerous associations and boards, including the YMCA, Ohio Sickle Cell, Franklin County Leadership to Reduce Infant Mortality, the Blue Chip Youth Education and the Columbus Cancer Clinic. In recognition of his accomplishments, he also is the recipient of many awards, including the Teacher of the Year Award from Grant Medical Center and the Special Ties Award for his work with disadvantaged children.
