Birth and Death Certificates (Vital Statistics)

Description: Registers and issues certified copies of Franklin County birth and death certificates dating back to 1908. There is a fee of \$20 for each certified copy. Same day service is available for death certificate requests 10 am – 2 pm daily. Requests for certified copies of birth certificates will be processed on a mail out or next business day pick-up basis only. Our pickup window will be open 8 am – 4:15 pm Monday, Tuesday & Thursday and 9 am – 4:15 pm Friday. Debit/Credit card service is available by telephone (1-877-648-0605) via fax (614-645-0730) or online at www.vitalchek.com. There is an additional \$9.95 service fee for debit/credit card service. Mail requests take approximately 7-10 business days. Newborn certificates take approximately 8-10 weeks to be received from the hospital and registered in our office. Application forms are available online at www.publichealth.columbus.gov.

Immunization Services (Childhood and Adult Shots)

Description: Shots for children under 19 years at minimal cost. Medicaid, Medicare Part B, CareSource, Molina Health Care of Ohio & United Health Care accepted. Adult shots are given at cost of the vaccine, including an administration fee plus a \$15.00 assessment charge. No adult immunizations available for change of immigration status. Tuberculosis (TB) Control Program

Description: The control and treatment of Tuberculosis for Franklin County residents. Services include: Targeted TB screenings for high-risk clients, nursing assessments for x-ray referrals, contact investigations & follow-up, direct observational therapy and community education. 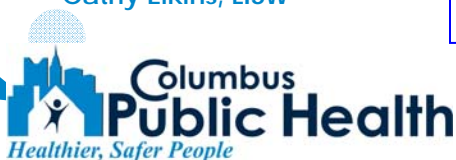
