

The 2005 Franklin County Community Health Risk Assessment is a collaborative project prepared by Columbus Public Health with the support of The Columbus Foundation, Columbus Medical Association Foundation, Mt. Carmel Foundation, Nationwide Children's Hospital, The Ohio State University Medical Center, OhioHealth, Osteopathic Heritage Foundation, the United Way of Central Ohio, the Franklin County Board of Health and the Ohio Department of Health.

A total of 2,242 adult interviews were collected for the 2005 Franklin County Community Health Risk Assessment. For further comparative information see the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS).
